On Monday, September 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2014 at 3:52 PM Duluth Police were called to area of 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue East and 4<sup>th</sup> Street for an armed robbery that just occurred.

Initial investigation revealed the 24 year old male victim was just robbed at knife point. The suspect left on foot, westbound 4<sup>th</sup> Street . No one was injured. Officers located a male matching the suspect's description nearby; he was identified as Joseph Lee Morrow, a 23 year old male resident of Duluth. Morrow was found with the victim's backpack and other stolen items. The knife believed to be used in the robbery was also located on Morrow.

Joseph Morrow has the following convictions in Minnesota:

2012 – Felony Escape from Custody

2012 – False Information to Police

2011 – Felony Receiving Stolen Property

2011 – Misdemeanor Theft

Joseph Morrow was arrested and brought to the Saint Louis County Jail for Aggravated Robbery and 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Assault.
