This event is a day dedicated to volunteering and cleaning up beaches and shorelines along all five Great Lakes. September's Adopt-a-Beach Event is part of the International Coastal Cleanup, and Duluth is excited to be joining millions of people caring for their local shorelines all over the world as part of this effort.
