It is a fun day for the whole family. Enjoy fresh local produce, local artisan crafts, tasty seasonal foods, and other offerings from over 100 vendors. Children will enjoy a bounce house, face painting & other activities. One of the most popular attractions is the farmers market, with fresh caramel

apples, sweet cider and locally grown sweet corn. The park stage will feature live music ongoing throughout the day. Acoustic folk/rock performer Greg Tibirzi will play from 10am-noon, followed by Matt Wahl from noon to 2:00 PM and Doug Greenwood from 2:00-4:00 PM. There is no admission fee, but a suggested donation of \$2, with all proceeds going to support flood recovery for the youth ski program at Chester Bowl. Due to the popularity of the festival, to help with parking, two shuttle buses will run from 9:30 to 4:30 PM from UMD's Darland Administrative building parking lot to Chester Bowl, transporting people free of charge.
